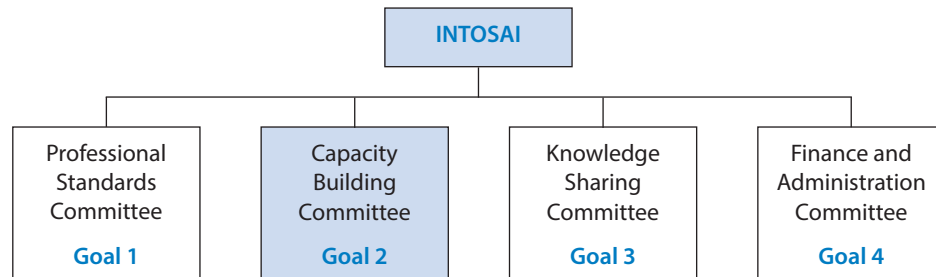


# INTOSAI Capacity Building Committee: Background briefing

## Who are we?

The INTOSAI Capacity Building Committee (CBC) is one of the four strategic committees of INTOSAI serving to implement the INTOSAI's strategic goals. CBC's main tasks are to build the capabilities and professional capacities of Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs) through training, technical assistance and other development activities. In doing so, CBC fosters the transfer and application of knowledge and skills relating to SAIs' organisation and work so that SAIs are able to perform their functions to the highest professional standards.



### What do we do?

- Working with the regions: CBC has created a forum for the INTOSAI regions to share information and experiences and to shape the agenda of the CBC.
- Production of good practice guides: CBC members identify areas where good practice guides are needed. Working groups are then formed to develop the guides. They are published on the CBC website [www.intosaicbc.org](http://www.intosaicbc.org) and translated into key INTOSAI languages by CBC members.
- Dissemination: The Guides are sent to all SAIs electronically and, with funding from the UK Department for International Development and others, IDI help run regional workshops to ensure that individual SAIs are provided with an opportunity to understand the guides and adapt the contents for their own institutional environment.

- Database: The CBC created a database of capacity building project and have asked IDI to host and manage the ongoing development – [www.saidevelopment.org/default.aspx](http://www.saidevelopment.org/default.aspx)
- Coordination: CBC aims to provide a forum for all those engaged in capacity building within INTOSAI to exchange ideas and experiences and ensure coordination – strong links have been forged with IDI and the INTOSAI-Donor Cooperation.
