Capacity Building Committee Work stream in support of IntoSAINT

IntoSAINT is a self-assessment tool that SAIs can use for analyzing their integrity risks and assessing the maturity of their integrity management systems. The tool is targeted at preventing corruption and generates a list of management recommendations for supporting the integrity of the organization in question. It is a management tool enabling the user to design a tailor-made integrity policy and at the same time to raise integrity-awareness among its staff.

IntoSAINT was integrated as a CBC work stream in 2013. The work stream group consists of representatives from AFROSAI-E, ARABOSAI, ASEANSAI, CREFIAF, OLACEFS, PASAI, European Court of Auditors and the IDI. SAI Netherlands has led the development and roll-out of IntoSAINT in INTOSAI until 2016. SAI Mexico has agreed to take over the leadership and continue the work from 2017 onwards.

Areas of responsibility

- Promote IntoSAINT as a capacity de-velopment tool, and encourage the use and further development in support of the continuous development of integrity and accountability within the public sector in general and in SAIs in particular
- Proposal for rolling out IntoSAINT instrument, moderator facilities and evaluation and followup system within all regions
- Identifying best existing forum at inter-national level for sharing experiences and updating the tool at regular intervals. Funding issue will also be addressed.

- Ensure synergies between IntoSAINT roll-out and regional activities to support ISSAI 12 and to implement SAI-PMF, ISSAI 30 and the IDI Fraud and Corruption programme.
- Continue lobbying for SAIs to dedicate own budget as well as for donor support to fund the roll-out of IntoSAINT.
